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#### Introduction

The English (Learning Disabilities) Year 2 package consists of a textbook and an activity book specifically designed for the pupils with varied learning disabilities. It is written in accordance to the Standard-Based Curriculum for Primary Schools (Learning Disabilities).

The package is prepared to equip the pupils with basic foundation of language skills to enable them to communicate effectively in various contexts according to their different learning abilities.

#### The Textbook

The textbook consists of 12 units with diverse topics. Each unit introduces the pupils to four language skills which are listening, speaking, reading, and writing. In addition, language arts section is also introduced to promote creative and enjoyable learning elements for the pupils. Additional suggestions for further enrichment are included in the Teacher's Notes.

This component aims to develop the pupils' ability to listen and respond according to the given stimuli. The pupils are introduced to simple listening and speaking activities. The elements of songs and nursery rhymes are also incorporated to promote fun learning.
